With a total length of 12.6 km, the Wedeler Au is the longest tributary of the Elbe originating in Hamburg. We are committed to the ecological enhancement of the Wedeler Au.

Goals:

- ✓ Creating tideways to increase the tidal influence in the marsh,
- ✓ Building ponds to provide habitats for amphibians, dragonflies and other insects
- ✓ Flattening banks and developing wetland habitats,
- ✓ Cultivating wet reed beds, perfect breeding habitats for birds like the reed warbler and others,
- ✓ Planting willows, contributing to future stepstones for the endangered Elbe water-dropwort
- ✓ Developing islands for waders and waterfowl.

Costs: € 1.6 million
